






### **Portfolio Objective and Strategy**

Objective: The primary objective of the fund is to achieve long-term growth of at least US CPI + 5% per annum. Long term means over rolling periods exceeding 6 years.

Strategy: The fund will achieve its objectives by investing in multiple asset classes, geographics and currencies, both directly via listed instruments or indirectly through participatory interest in collective investment schemes. To reduce volatility of returns, the fund will have exposure to various investment styles, including, but not limited to value, quality and growth investing.

## **Monthly Commentary**

IZA Global Balanced Fund was slightly down in sterling in August and up 2.2% in USD, outperforming its benchmark. The fund has recently been consistently ranking in the top two quartiles. While the USD class has outperformed, the GBP class has been struggling due to the extreme currency movements. The US dollar continued its weakening trend against the British pound, driven by a notable divergence in monetary policy approaches between the Federal Reserve and the Bank of England. The Fed's indication of a pause or slowing in further rate hikes, prompted by easing inflation and slower US growth, contrasted with the Bank of England's maintained hawkish stance, providing ongoing support for sterling. However, the pound's momentum against the dollar is expected to persist near current levels, trading within a range between 1.34 and 1.36. While we are closely monitoring the currency shifts, we also remain proactive on the active management of the currency risk.

Overall, the underlying's have delivered decent performance amidst the geopolitical tensions, tariff wars and the anticipation of rate cuts. The portfolio has benefitted from the performance of the Prescient China Balanced Fund holding and Gold. On the latter, we still maintain a bullish view despite some analysts dialing back their enthusiasm which is largely based on the view that appetite for gold will dwindle as markets start to stabilize and investor risk appetite returns. The IZA Global Balanced Fund remains well diversified both at a sector and asset allocation level, providing investors with ample opportunity across the risk spectrum.

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
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

## Glossary of Terms

**Standard Deviation** is a measure of the dispersion of a set of data from its mean. When applied to an annual rate of return it sheds light on the historical volatility of the investment.

Sharpe Ratio is a measure for calculating risk-adjusted return. It is the average return earned in excess of the risk-free rate per unit of total risk.

**Maximum Drawdown** is the is measure of the the maximum observed loss from a peak to trough of a portfolio, before a new peak is attained. It is a an indicator of downside risk over a given period.

Sortino ratio is a measure for calculating the performance of an investment relative to its downside deviation. It is the average return earned in excess of the risk-free rate divided by the investments' downside risk.
